

Frederic Remington Arts Festival Student Art Competition Guidelines

Eligibility: The competition is open to students in grades 7 through 12. Each art teacher is asked to select *five pieces* of student art to submit for the competition.

Theme: Remington and his Media

Media: Flat work, matted and ready to hang, and small sculptures (space is limited, please limit the size to about 36" x 24")*

Labels: Please include title, artist's name, grade, school, art teacher's name, telephone number of student, and telephone number of art teacher

Deadline: All entries must be received at the Canton Free Library by 3 p.m. on Wednesday, September 23.

Judging: Judges will meet to review entries at 4 p.m. on September 24. Late arrivals may be displayed but will not be entered in the competition

Prizes: Prizes in the form of gift certificates will be awarded. Participation certificates will be awarded to all entrants. Prizes will be awarded at a reception at the Canton Free Library, Saturday, September 26, at 10:30 a.m. All students with entries are encouraged to attend.

Pick-up: All entries must be picked up from the Canton Free Library no later than 12 noon on Saturday, October 24.
