

§ 437 Notice of election

The village clerk must publish, at least ten days prior to any village election, a notice which must state: (1) the polling place in each election district; (2) the hours during which the polls will be open; (3) the names and addresses of all those who have been duly nominated in accordance with the provisions of the Election Law for village office by certificate or petition of nomination duly filed with the village clerk, and the office and term of such office for which they have been so nominated; and (4) an abstract of any proposition to be voted upon.¹ In addition to such publication, a copy of the notice must be posted in at least six conspicuous public places within the village and at each polling place at least one day before the village election.²

The board of trustees of a village must, at least 60 days before any village election conducted by either the village clerk or the board of elections on a date other than the date of the general election, adopt a resolution which must state: (1) the polling place in each election district; and (2) the hours during which the polls will be open, which must include at least hours from noon to 9:00 p.m.³

§ 438 —Special election

Notice of a special village election for officers must be given in the same manner as for a general village election.¹ If the offices of all trustees and mayor are vacant, the notice must be given by the village clerk, and if the office of village clerk is also vacant, the election may be held at the call of, and noticed by, at least 25 residents qualified to vote for village office.²
